CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITOR CONTRACT

Payment Deadline and Cancellation

Payment of 50 % of the total sum will be due upon receipt of the contract and the balance of 50 % is due on or before March 15th 2010. Refund will only be issued if there is a waiting list for booth space. Otherwise, refunds will not be granted.

Display Conditions

- Display must conform to the size of the space reserved
- No display may protrude into the aisle
- No display shall exceed 10 feet in height without permission from CanSIA -
- No booths may interfere with direct visibility of an adjoining display
- The exhibitor is responsible for arranging for any carpet, furnishings, electrical or internet needs, etc. An exhibitor kit will be provided to you via email prior to the show.

Tradeshow Times

Set up and dismantling can occur only during the times noted on page one. The exhibitor is responsible for the installation, demonstration and dismantling of displays. These times are subject to change.

Additional Conditions

The Canadian Solar Industries Association (CanSIA) shall not be responsible for loss, damage or injury that may occur prior to, during or subsequent to the period covered in the exhibit contract. The exhibitor, on signing the contract, expressly releases CanSIA from and agrees to indemnify same against any and all claims for such loss, damage or injury, including vehicles.

No alteration or variation of terms of this agreement shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by CanSIA.

If an exhibitor defaults on any terms or conditions of this agreement, CanSIA has the right to immediately occupy the space of the defaulting exhibitor and use it as deemed appropriate. The exhibitor shall pay all sums due the exhibition under this agreement and all costs and expenses of legal counsel employed by CanSIA if such services are necessary.

In the event of an emergency, CanSIA reserves the right to revoke the privileges stated above without liability except for the refund of the exhibitor's payment up to that time.
