

Centrosolar Canada to Exhibit at CanSIA Solar Canada 2011, December 5-6 in Toronto

*~ Company to Showcase its Ontario-Made S-Series PV Panel and Recently Completed
Ontario Solar Projects at Booth # 1501~*

Toronto, Ontario--November 21-2011 – Centrosolar Canada, a subsidiary of Munich-based CENTROSOLAR Group AG, today announced that the Ontario-made S-Series solar PV panel will be on industry display for the first time at CanSIA's Solar Canada 2011, Canada's premiere solar industry conference. Currently installed on dozens of rooftops across the Province, Solar Canada represents the opportunity for many Canadian installers to see the S-Series panels for the first time.

Introduced to the Canadian solar market in May, the S-Series module delivers reliable performance levels in cloudy and lower-sun areas and under the weather conditions found in Canada. The S-Series comes standard with MC4 connectors and provides a positive power tolerance rating of 0/+4.99W. It is also available in Centrosolar's CentroPack®, all-in-one, pre-packaged PV system.

“The Ontario-made S-Series PV panels are gaining a lot of traction with installers in Ontario, said Centrosolar Canada General Manager Bob Waddell. “In this relatively new industry, the reliability of German-engineered panels—whether manufactured in Germany or right here in Ontario-- goes a long way.”

Building on Centrosolar's leadership position in the European and US solar markets, Centrosolar Canada has established a strong presence in Ontario since launching operations here in November 2010.

Centrosolar Canada and Ontario-based solar integrator EnviroEn-Inc. recently completed a 135kW rooftop FIT solar project that was installed at Dubwear headquarters in Mississauga, Ontario. Dubwear is a custom clothing provider to over 300 Canadian and US universities, travel operators, camps and corporations. Approximately 495 Centrosolar E275 solar PV modules were installed under the Ontario Feed-In-Tariff program.

Centrosolar Canada also recently partnered with Solsmart to donate a 4.5kW solar system at Evergreen Brickworks, a non-profit that makes cities more livable. Centrosolar Canada provided the panels, inverter and mounting components to Evergreen and Solsmart did the installation that will help to provide solar power to the LEED Platinum Evergreen building at the Brickworks in Toronto. “The system is reflective of a typical residential installation and we feel it is important to contribute to organizations such as Evergreen that are working so hard to enhance the urban environment and demonstrate sustainability” said Bob Waddell.
